
Valencia, 21<sup>st</sup> february 2008

As you know, **European Pond Conservation Network (EPCN)**, is preparing 3<sup>rd</sup> **EPCN Workshop**. The 3rd Workshop is being organised by the *Conselleria de Medi Ambient, Aigua, Urbanisme i Habitatge of the Generalitat Valenciana (Regional Government of the Valencian Region, Spain). This event will take place from 14 th to 16th May 2008 in Valencia (Spain).* 

Now, is time that authors submit abstracts, unpublished research papers that are not being considered for publication in any other forum and related with topics of the Workshop (please, see in Official Website). The abstract will be submitted via website, in www.lifeanfibios.com/epcn/submissions, available until March 28th 2008. Organization can not accept abstracts submitted after this date. Please, observe the next conditions (note that exist <u>some relevant modifications</u> on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Communication sent):

- The abstract will content less than 200 words.
- You have to fill completely the submission form. Is specially important that you assign your abstract in a topic.
- The closing date for submissions is 28<sup>th</sup> march 2008.
- Time for sessions of oral presentations is limited. Then, Scientific Committee could ask you for changing in mode of presentation (oral communication to poster presentation).
- The author or at least one of the co-authors must be registered for the Workshop before 28<sup>th</sup> March 2008. More than one abstract can be submitted per author or co-author.

Attendants can try two modes of participation, via Poster Presentation or Oral Communication. In both cases, acceptation of its abstract is required. Organisers will exhibit all abstracts (posters and oral communication) received by 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2008 at the Workshop Website.



## 1. Poster presentations

There will be two Poster Sessions on Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> May and Thursday 15 May in the Poster Hall in La Petxina Complex.

- The maximum width for each poster is 100 cm. The maximum poster high is 120 cm. But, we suggest the standard format A0 (841x1189 mm).
- Posters should be easily legible from a viewing distance of 1 m. The title should be at least 2 cm high, with the smallest lettering no less than 0,8 cm high.
- Use an easy-to-read font (Arial, Times New Roman, Verdana or Futura are the more commonly used).
- Underline the author who present the poster.
- You may wish to prepare at least 20 A4 copies of your poster, making it easier for interested colleagues to read.

## 2. Oral comunications

The Oral comunications will extend for a maximum of 15 minutes each, and 5 additional minutes for dialog. All sessions will be moderated by a Chairman, who can modify Schedule if necessary.

Organization suggest include a Power Point presentation, in all cases compatible with Microsoft Power Point 2002 (please, if you use a latter version, mind export to MPP 2002).

Just after acceptation of your Oral Communication, Organization will publish a detailed Schedule in the Website.
